GLENHOPE VINEYARD



Winemaker Scott Harrington Origin Macedon

Glenhope Vineyard is a grower vineyard sitting just below 500m ASL in the northeast of the Macedon region, and its fruit is much sought-after by local producers including Bindi's Dhillon label, Latta Vino, Silent Way, ECK Wines, Wilimee and Joshua Cooper. The 2022 vintage marks the debut release of a collection of small-batch wines under the Glenhope Vineyard label.

The site is located on an east-facing slope at the northern end of the Macedon region which offers a more stable continental influence with a large diurnal temperature range (sunny days, cool nights) for a longer hangtime, optimal fruit ripeness, acid retention and phenolic maturity. The soil profile ranges from granitic at the elevated easterly-facing western end of the site to sandy loam, with an ironstone-rich volcanic pocket on the eastern ridge.

NOVA VITA



Winemaker Mark Kozned Origin Adelaide Hills

The philosophy at Nova Vita is to make outstanding examples of cool-climate wines, with an emphasis on sustainable practices in both the vineyard and winery.

The cool days and cooler nights in the Adelaide Hills offer extended ripening conditions into Autumn, and the two breezy sites allow for a greater opportunity for minimal-input viticulture. Biological systems are well-established in the two Nova Vita vineyards for pest control and disease, and biodynamic practices are being rolled out on targeted vineyard blocks, as the impact on each site is investigated.

Nova Vita were able to turn adversity into opportunity, using the replanting required after the December 2019 Adelaide Hills bushfires to go further in re-establishing the burnt sections of vineyard with better-suited varieties and rootstocks, pushing closer towards minimal-input viticulture.

The Project K wines represent recent developments in both style and sustainability in the cool Adelaide Hills – handpicked, wild yeast fermented in small batches, then bottled unfiltered and with minimal sulphites. Also vegan friendly – as is the whole Firebird range.

Matriarch & Rogue wines are an exploration of the Clare Valley subregions, together with single-site, single-varietal, smallbatch viticulture and winemaking. Riesling from Watervale, Shiraz from Armagh, Fiano and Sangiovese from Leasingham and all from single-grower, single-site fruit sources.

The made by m&r range is a broadening of focus from Clare, in search of the right varieties on the right site, be that Waikerie for Montepulciano or the Adelaide Hills for Nero d'Avola.

Rogues of the Resistance are small-batch varieties whose origins come from lands far, far away – typically from points further towards the new and emerging end of the alternative varietal spectrum. Every year they celebrate their resistance to our ever-evolving environment.

From a base in Margaret River, Borrello Vineyards draw fruit from estate-managed vineyards in whichever of the Western Australian regions their single varietals grow best – from Frankland River comes a spicy Shiraz that nods in the direction of the Northern Rhone. From (of course) Margaret River comes a Chardonnay and a Cabernet. There's a textural, complex Trebbiano and a highly-gluggable Grenache from the Swan Valley too. All the fruit makes it way to Margaret River for elevage under the watchful eye of ex-Leeuwin Estate head winemaker Paul Atwood.

Dean prefers to shift more of the work into getting the vineyard right, leading to less required in the winery. Biodynamic and organic practices are used wherever appropriate, minimal intervention the mantra.

BROCKENCHACK

Eden Valley

From a single vineyard in the Eden Valley, Brockenchack's oldest vines are patches of Riesling that date back to 1896, and Shiraz from 1927.

Like the rest of the Eden Valley, Brockenchack's Home Block enjoys plenty of sunshine but less heat and slightly higher rainfall than nearby regions. This translates to healthier canopies, retained acidity and longer hang times for fruit. This gradual ripening produces excellent complexity and flavour development and typically healthier fruit.

A family owned endeavour, Trevor and Marilyn Harch named the property Brockenchack as a portmanteau of their four grandchildrens' names: Bronte, Mackenzie, Charli and Jack.

In late 2022, a fully-equipped winery was built onsite, followed in early 2023 by a bottling hall, allowing the fruit from vintage 2023 to be processed from vine to bottle on the Home Block vineyard.
